As an auxiliary exhibition to American Impressionism, this exhibition will take a renewed look at Columbus' most important Impressionist, Alice Schille. An impressive array of Schille's masterpieces, in both oil and watercolor, will be assembled for the exhibition to present more fully the artist's explorations in the boundaries of color and light that mark the central concern of Impressionism.
